Quadrennial learning cycle of the SD policy Federal Act of 1997

Federal Report on SD - assessment of Monitoring of the Plan existing situation - assessment of current policy - prospective vision **Implementation** Quadrennial of the Plan learning cycle

Participation of civil society

Federal Plan for SD

- measures to be taken to reach SD goals
- action plan establishing implementation modalities





Learning Sustainable Development Policy by interacting with experts panels and institutions outside FPB

2007: Long term participatory foresight

A panel of 16 experts outside FBP has launched the construction of 2 2050 scenarios on 4 subsystems of society:



Consumption (& society)



Energy (& society)



Production (& society)



Food (& society)

2009: Interactive analysis of SD Indicators

The 51 information sheets are based on interactions with 40 thematic Experts outside the Task Force: 30% in FPB and 70% outside FPB





Recommendations of the 2007 Report

- Based on 2050 SD scenarios
- Built in a participative exercise





Cross-cutting recommendations on Federal Policy

- Enforce Federal SD policy on the basis of the Constitution
 - Adopting "sound" SD(LT) policy objectives and targets (on sound foundations)
 - Improving ex-ante (SIA) & ex-post (monitoring) SD policy assessment
 - Interlinking thematic plans with common objectives improving their coherence
 - Integrating foresight thinking in national SD strategy preparations.
- Enforce efforts of Belgium in multilateral policy
 - Interlinking SD external policy to SD internal policy
 - > Interlinking SD external policy to development cooperation policy

Recommendations on SCP policies

- Insert in the SD Federal Plan a common framework for SCP Federal policies
- Promote Corporate Social Responsibility as well as consumers social responsibility





Recommendations of the 2009 Report

- Based on a comparative study of synthetic indicators
- And on a table of indicators with strategic SD objectives





Cross-cutting and specific recommendations concerning indicators cf. Stiglitz Report (SR)

 Do not over-limit the number of synthetic indicators that are adopted and publicly debated (SR)












- Make an inventory of gaps in the current data as a matter of urgency and agree on efforts to fill them (SR) especially in BE
- Take into account the logic of the system in structuring lists or tables of sustainable development indicators
- Define monitoring indicators (to follow implementation) as soon as each policy decision is adopted
- Increase society's consensus on SD policies by encouraging debates about indicators, objectives and LT cross-cutting visions.
